# COMPETITION RULES

#### Forms / Patterns competition

1. Single elimination format will be followed for all Patterns competition competitions, with semi-finalists competing for 3rd place. (Same format as the sparring competition, where 2 competitors will go up and compete at the same time, the winner of the 2 will move on to the next stage.)

#### Sparring / Sparring competition

1. Competitors must have full equipment in good working order, including chest protector, head gear, forearm guards, shin guards, groin cup and mouth guard. Gloves & foot protectors will be optional.
2. All sparring competition, except for Jr. A Black Belt and Olympic Weight Divisions will be in single Elimination format.
3. All Colour Belts, Jr. C & Jr. D Black Belts will be subject to the NO HIGH-SECTION CONTACT rule.
4. Jr. B, Executive & Veteran Black Belts will be allowed CONTROLLED high section contact.
5. Jr. A Black Belts will use a Round Robin Format the semi finals stage to determine the medalists, with only 1 Bronze medal to be awarded. The athlete with the most wins at the Round Robin stage will be declared. (withdrawals considered as wins) WTF full contact sparring competition rules will apply.



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6. Sr. Olympic Weight Divisions will use a Round Robin Format after the Preliminary Tournament (Seeding/Ranking Phase will be single elimination, with the semi-finalists competing for 3 rd spot) to qualify for the Round Robin as Seeds #1,#2 & #3. WTF full contact sparring competition rules will apply. Please read modified procedure:
  - I. Seed#1 from Ranking Phase will start the round robin with a record of one win.
  - II. The other athletes in the round robin will start with zero wins
  - III. Once the round robin is complete the athlete with the most wins will be declared.
  - IV. If there is a tie, the two tied athletes will have another determining match.
  - V. If there is a 3 way tie, final standings will reflect according to Ranking Phase results.
7. **\*NEW\*** Military/Armed Forces Division! (Gold medalists will compete to advance to their respective Olympic Weight Division in the Round Robin Tournament as Seed #4.)
8. Match Duration: Colour Belts
  - Youth ages 15 & under 1.5 min – 1 round
  - Adult ages 16 & over 1.5 min – 1 round
9. Match Duration: Black Belts
  - Jr. C,D, 1 min – 2 rounds
  - Jr. B, Executive & Veterans 1.5 min – 2 rounds
  - Jr. A & Olympic Weights 1.5 min – 2 rounds

### Weigh-In Instructions

**All Day 2 competitors are required to weigh-in.**

1. Weigh-in will take place on Saturday, November 15, from 2:30 to 6pm
2. Weigh-in will be conducted at the tournament site
3. Competitors will have unlimited opportunity to weigh-in within the scheduled weigh-in timeframe
4. Competitors who fail to make weight will be “bumped” to the next appropriate division
5. Competitors who fail to attend weigh-in on Saturday will be disqualified from Sunday’s competition.
6. Brackets will be posted on Sunday at tournament site
